

Off-Peak tickets



Off-Peak tickets are available for travel at quieter times during the week, after 9:26am on Fridays and anytime at the weekend. You can travel on an Off-Peak ticket on the times shown below. Ask a member of staff at your [local station](#) if you're still unsure.

You can travel TO London using an Off-Peak ticket on the train time below for each destination and any train thereafter.

You can travel FROM London using an Off-Peak ticket anytime after the morning peak finishes with the exception of the 'NOT VALID' times shown below.
