Engineering works are taking place on the following dates:

Monday 24 and Thursday 27 December

London Euston to Milton Keynes Central

On both dates, timetables will be altered, with a reduced service on the London Euston to the West Midlands and Manchester Piccadilly routes. This means that services on the North Wales route will operate between Crewe and Holyhead.

Thursday 27 December 2018 until Tuesday 1 January 2019

Runcorn to Liverpool Lime Street

Services will be diverted between Crewe and Liverpool Lime Street via Warrington Bank Quay, with increased journey times and without calling at Runcorn. Rail replacement coaches will operate between Crewe – Runcorn, and Runcorn – Liverpool Lime Street.

Sunday 30 December 2018

London Euston

A reduced service will operate on the London Euston to the West Midlands and Manchester Piccadilly routes, while services on the North Wales route will operate between Crewe and Holyhead only.

Tuesday 1 January 2019

Motherwell to Glasgow Central

Rail replacement coaches will run all day between Carlisle and Glasgow Central, without calling at Lockerbie or Motherwell.

Edinburgh Station

Services will be diverted in the Edinburgh station area, increasing overall journey times to and from Carlisle, and won't be calling at Haymarket or Lockerbie.

Wolverhampton to Stafford

Until midday, rail replacement coaches will operate between Wolverhampton and Crewe.

Off-Peak tickets

You can travel on an Off-Peak ticket at any time after 09:26am on Fridays, over the weekend or on Bank Holidays. Since our trains are a little quieter over the festive season, we've added a few additional dates.

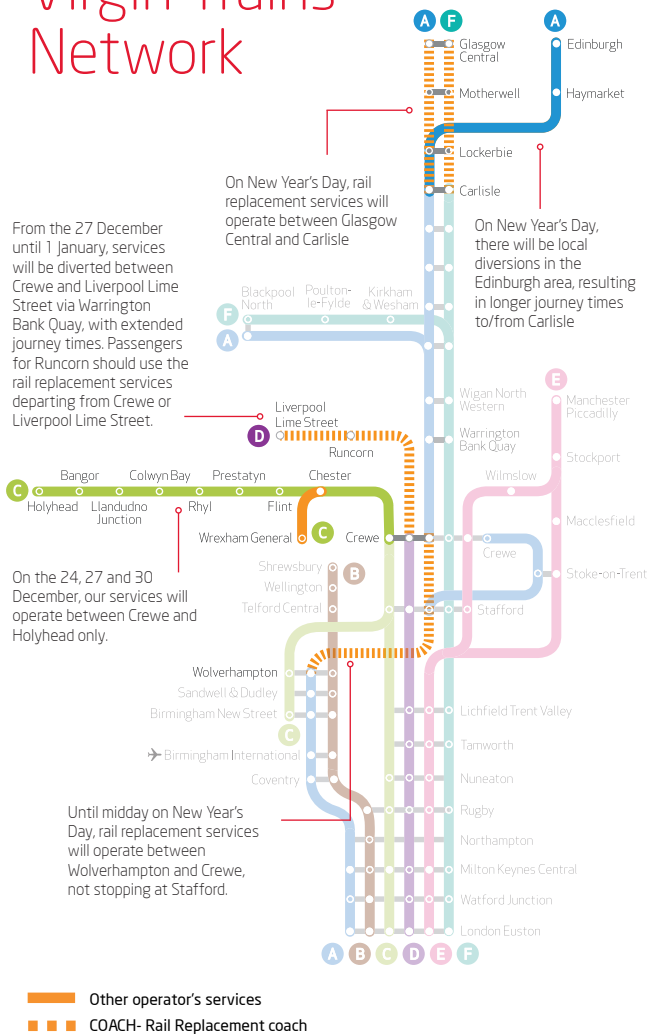
