What's happening?

Network Rail will be upgrading track and signalling at Acton Grange Junction, on the busy West Coast Main Line, just south of Warrington Bank Quay. During this sixteen-day period, from Saturday 20 July until Sunday 4 August, there will be no train services to / from Warrington Bank Quay.

This will impact our two Anglo – Scottish routes.

London Euston to / from Glasgow Central (direct)

These services will be diverted between Crewe and Wigan North Western, via Manchester Piccadilly, with extended journey times. We expect these diverted services to be extremely busy. Customers travelling between London Euston and Crewe / Stockport / Manchester are recommended not to travel on services, showing in journey planners as continuing through to Glasgow Central.

London Euston to / from Glasgow Central / Edinburgh via Birmingham.

These services will operate between:

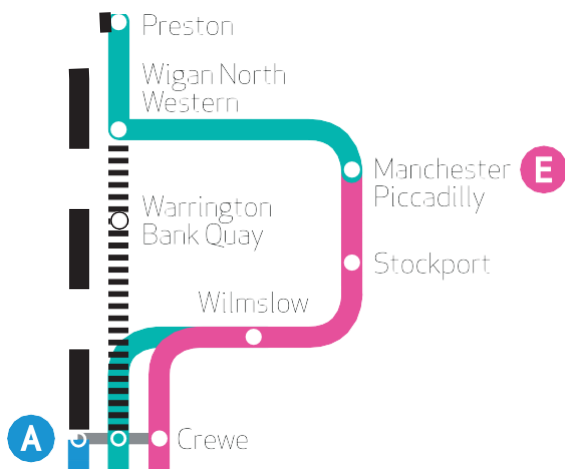
London Euston – Crewe.

Preston - Glasgow Central / Edinburgh.

If you are travelling between Crewe and Preston, our advice is to either travel on the diverted London Euston to / from Glasgow Central service (via Manchester Piccadilly), or use the rail replacement coach services, which will be operating non-stop between Crewe and Preston.

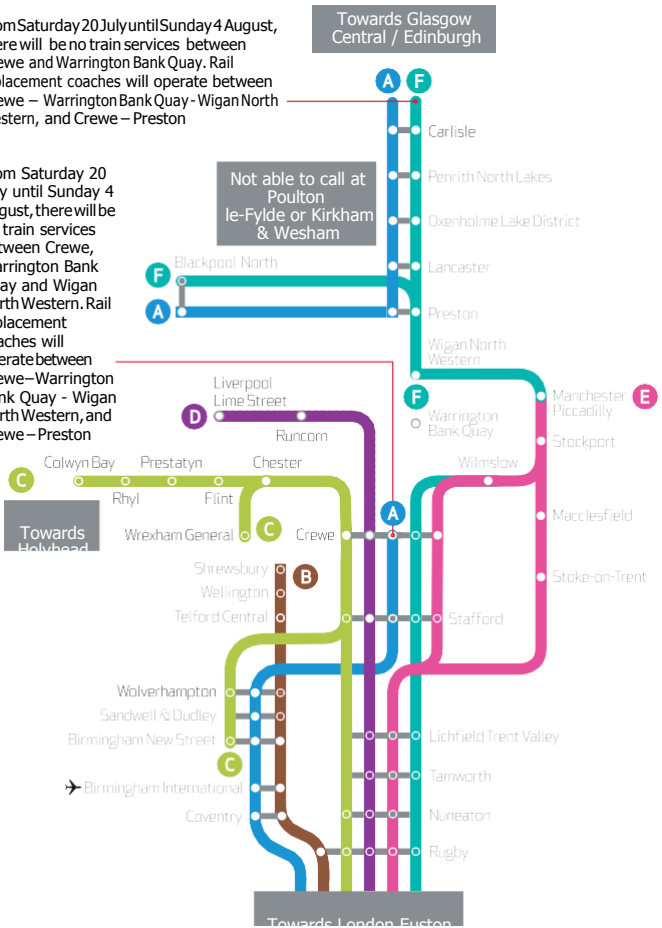
