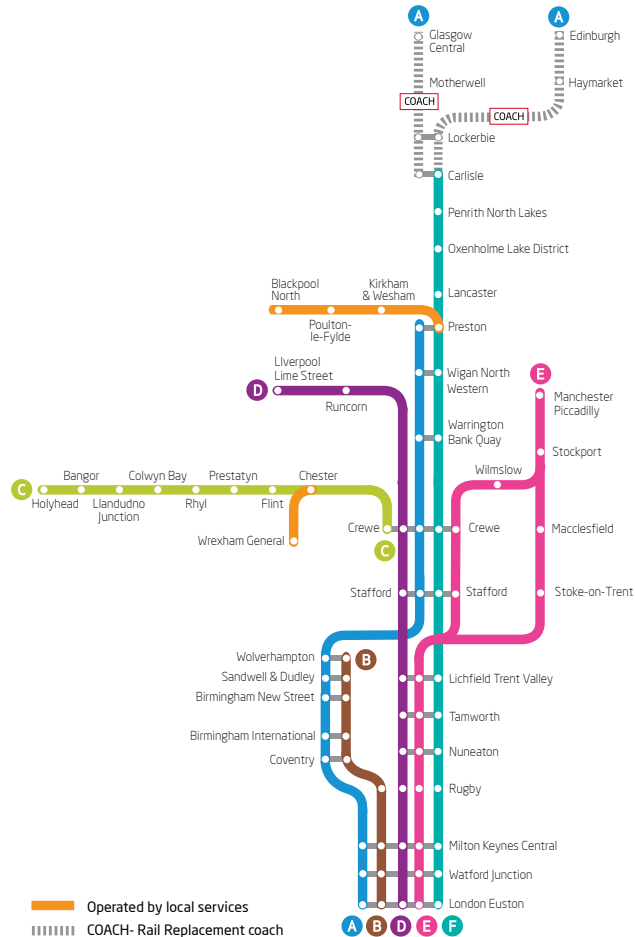

London Euston to/ from:

## Glasgow Central / Edinburgh (via the West Midlands)

Services will operate between London Euston and Preston. Passengers should change onto rail services between Preston and Carlisle, for onward travel. Rail replacement coaches will operate between Carlisle, Lockerbie and Glasgow Central / Edinburgh.

## Birmingham New Street / Wolverhampton

There will be two services per hour in each direction. One service will be the London Euston to Glasgow Central / Edinburgh service (terminating at Preston), via the West Midlands.

## Chester / Holyhead

Services will operate between Crewe and Holyhead.

## Liverpool Lime Street

Normal service.

## Manchester Piccadilly

There will be two services per hour in each direction. One service will operate via Crewe, whilst the other service will operate via Stoke-on-Trent.

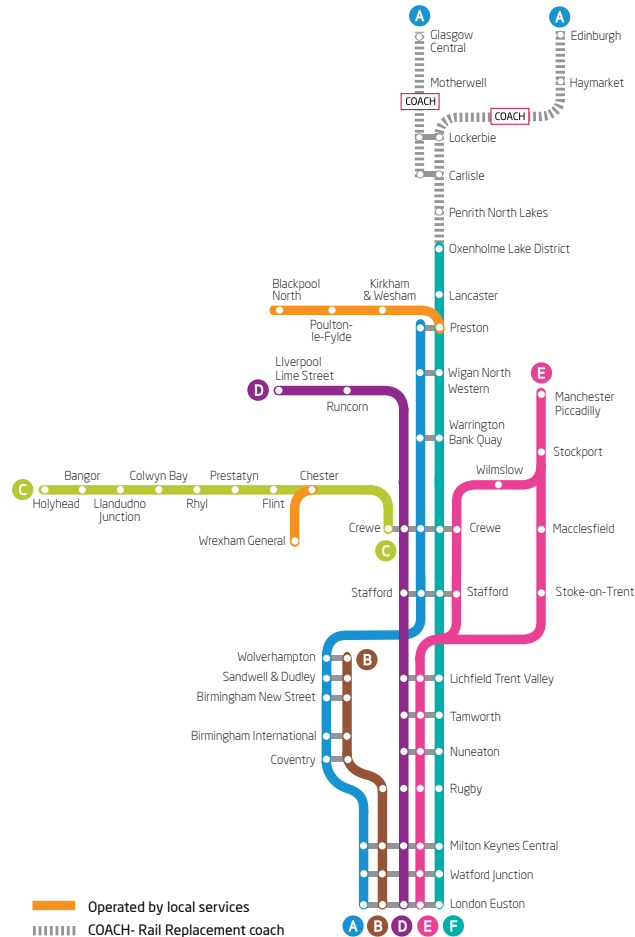
## Glasgow Central (direct route)

Services will operate between London Euston and Carlisle. Rail replacement coaches will operate between Carlisle, Lockerbie and Glasgow Central.

## Glasgow Central (direct route)

Services will operate between London Euston and Oxenholme Lake District. Rail replacement coaches will operate between Preston, Lancaster, Oxenholme Lake District, Penrith North lakes, Carlisle, Lockerbie and Glasgow Central.

A full timetable will operate to / from London Euston.

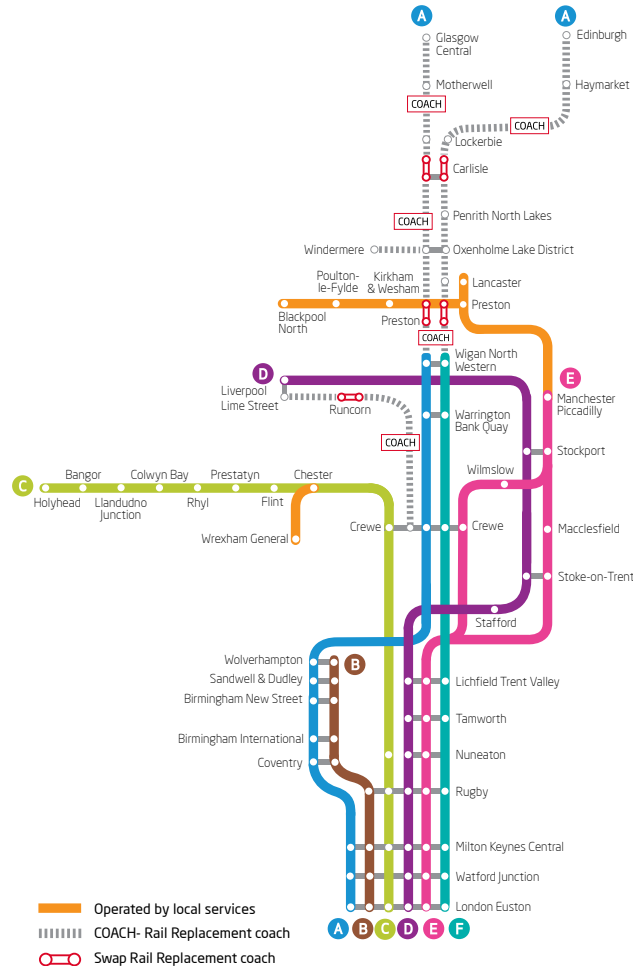
Average journey times of rail replacement coaches between stations:

Lancaster to Oxenholme Lake District	45 min
Oxenholme Lake District to Penrith North Lakes	55 min
Penrith North Lakes to Carlisle	35 min
Carlisle and Lockerbie	40 min
Carlisle and Glasgow Central	1 hr 55min
Carlisle and Edinburgh	2hr 40min

London Euston to/ from:

### Glasgow Central / Edinburgh (via the West Midlands)

Services will operate between London Euston and Preston until midday, then between London Euston and Wigan North West. Rail replacement coaches will operate between Wigan North West – Preston, Preston – Carlisle, Carlisle – Glasgow Central, and all stations that Virgin Trains would normally call. Rail replacement services will operate between Carlisle, Lockerbie and Edinburgh.

### Birmingham New Street / Wolverhampton

There will be two services per hour in each direction. One service will be the London Euston to Glasgow Central / Edinburgh service (terminating at Preston until midday, then at Crewe from midday onwards), via the West Midlands.

### Chester / Holyhead

Normal service.

### Liverpool Lime Street

Until midday, the normal service will operate. From midday onwards services will be diverted via Manchester Piccadilly (not calling).

### Manchester Piccadilly

There will be two services per hour in each direction. One service will operate via Crewe, whilst the other service will operate via Stoke-on-Trent.

### Glasgow Central (direct route)

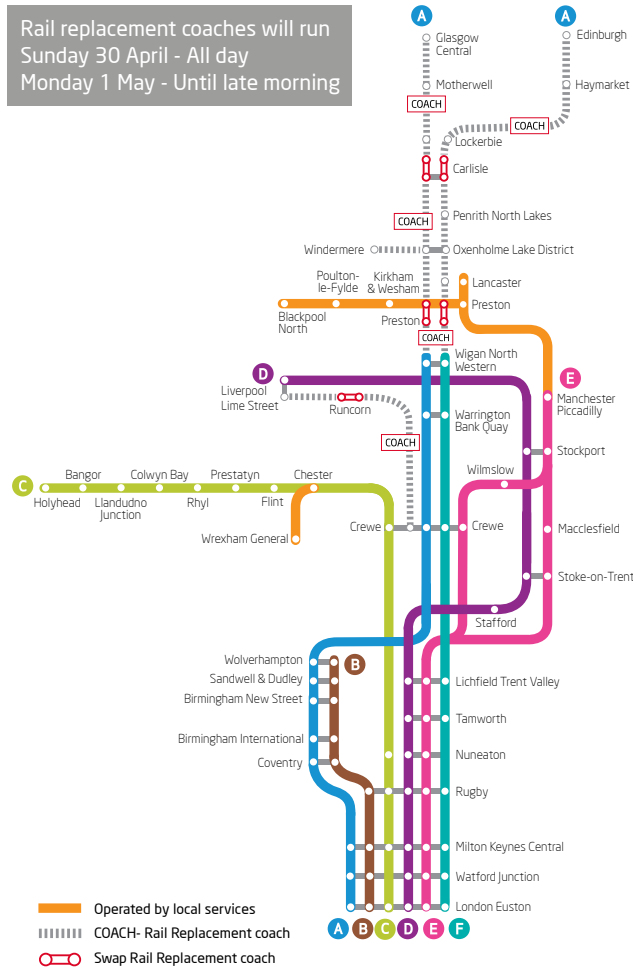

London Euston to/ from:

## Glasgow Central / Edinburgh (via the West Midlands)

Services will operate between London Euston and Wigan North West all day Sunday until midday on Monday. From midday on Monday, services will operate between London Euston and Preston. Rail replacement coaches will operate between Wigan North West – Preston, Preston – Carlisle, (all day Sunday until midday on Monday) Carlisle – Glasgow Central (all day both days), and all stations that Virgin Trains would normally call. Rail replacement services will operate between Carlisle, Lockerbie and Edinburgh (all day both days).

## Birmingham New Street / Wolverhampton

There will be two services per hour in each direction. One service will be the London Euston to Glasgow Central / Edinburgh service (terminating at Crewe all day Sunday, and Preston from midday onwards on Monday 1 May), via the West Midlands.

## Chester / Holyhead

Normal service.

## Liverpool Lime Street

All day Sunday and until midday on Monday, services will be diverted via Manchester Piccadilly (not calling)

## Manchester Piccadilly

There will be two services per hour in each direction. One service will operate via Crewe, whilst the other service will operate via Stoke-on-Trent.

## Glasgow Central (direct route)

Services will operate between London Euston and Wigan North West all day Sunday until midday on Monday. From midday on Monday, services will operate between London Euston and Preston. Rail replacement coaches will operate between Wigan North West – Preston, Preston – Carlisle, (all day Sunday until midday on Monday) Carlisle – Glasgow Central (all day both days), and all stations that Virgin Trains would normally call.
